The Government of Brunei Darussalam has broken ground on the 30MW solar PV power plant in Kampong Belimbing, the country's largest solar facility to date. Built on a 332,900-square-meter former landfill site in Kampong Belimbing, Mukim Kota Batu, the plant will generate over 64,000MWh of clean.

The designed solar energy system has a capacity of 60 kWp, producing 75 MWh of usable energy annually. This system uses 66% of the energy available from the sun to generate electricity which covers the electrical demand of Brunei's residences. Why is Brunei expanding solar energy use?
