What is a dollar-per-watt solar module?

The solar industry has historically used dollar-per-watt module pricing as the main financial metric used in decision-making. While this provides the upfront cost for a module, it can't give an accurate picture of its lifetime value.

When will 182mm module price report be based on 182*182-210mm format?

Weekly spot price report for 182mm modules will be based on the 182*182-210mm format from June 2024 onwards due to the slim price gap among varying formats . In India, domestically produced modules will be changed to TOPCon products, and the export price from China will be removed

from May 2025.
