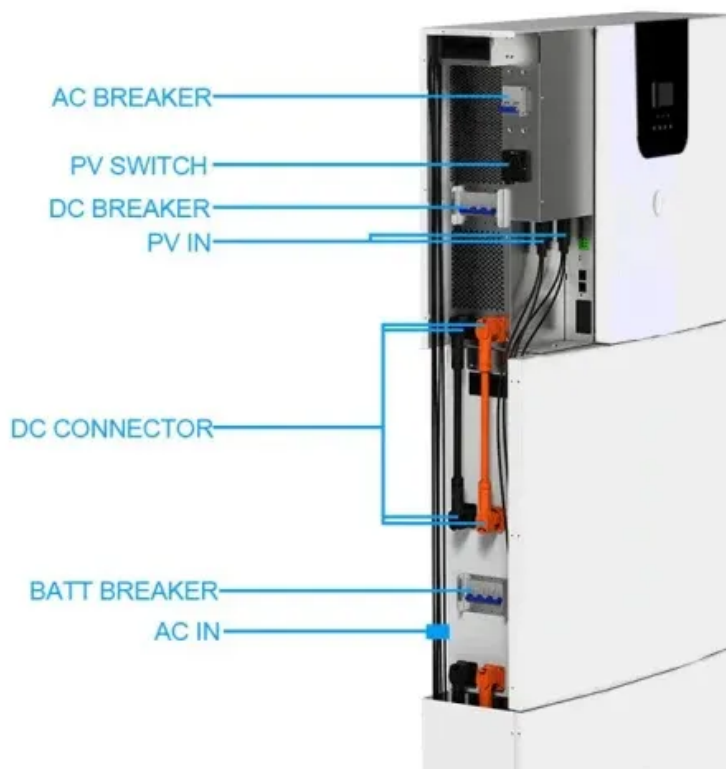

Living off the grid is mostly legal in Georgia. The main issue preventing you from going off-grid is waste disposal: in many areas, you must connect to the public sewer line. However, in rural areas, going off-grid is usually completely legal. The caveat is that you must get permits and follow.
