Overview

Can you get a phone in the Cook Islands?

Some of the outer Islands also have their own channels. Staying connected in the Cook Islands is easy with Vodafone, the country's main provider for mobile, internet, and landline services. You can buy a local SIM card at the airport or any Vodafone store, and choose from prepaid or monthly plans depending on your needs.

What telecommunications are available in the Cook Islands?

Telecommunications in the Cook Islands is limited by the country's low population and isolation, like most countries and territories in Oceania. There is only one major television broadcasting station and six radio stations. However, most residents have a main line or mobile phone.

How do I Activate my Cook Islands SIM card?

Once you have purchased your Cook Islands SIM card and inserted it into your phone, text "3T" to "888". You should then receive a prompt to say that your SIM is activated. The first go-to for most travellers arriving in Rarotonga and the Cook Islands is the pre-loaded Travel SIM offered by Vodafone Cook Islands.

Which SIM card should I buy in the Cook Islands?

If you want to buy the best SIM card in the Cook Islands, I recommend going with Vodafone (formerly BlueSky) because it is your only option (monopoly). Cook Islands has only one mobile operator offering prepaid services easily accessible to travelers:.

How many TV stations are there in Cook Islands?

There is only one major television broadcasting station and six radio stations. However, most residents have a main line or mobile phone. Its telecommunications are mainly provided by Telecom Cook Islands, who is

currently working with O3b Networks, Ltd. for faster Internet connection.

Does Cook Islands have Internet?

Until 2019, Telecom Cook Islands was the sole provider for internet, mobile and fixed telephone communications for the country. Internet was provided via satellite which was costly to the government with an unreliable connection especially to the outer islands.
