telcos, disclosed this in its November report.

Is Rwandatel competing with Tigo?

There was effective competition among three operators after Tigo launched services in 2009. However, the acquisition of Tigo by Airtel saw a significant consolidation in the market, and the cancellation of Rwandatel's licence in 2011 resulted in the market becoming a duopoly between the dominant operator MTN and Airtel.
