Although Cuba officially runs on 110V, many of the more modern hotels have 110/220V (dual voltage) outlets to cater to the lucrative European market.

What type of power outlet does Cuba use?

Cuba uses both Type A/B and Type C power outlets. Some hotels will use one type and others another, although plenty use both, sometimes even in the same room! As a result, you'll have to pack the proper adapter to recharge your devices while on the road.

What are the major imports of Cuba?

Imports The top imports of Cuba are Poultry Meat (\$330M), Wheat (\$153M), Concentrated Milk (\$107M), Crude Petroleum (\$70.2M), and Rice (\$66.9M), importing mostly from Spain (\$741M), China (\$574M), United States (\$309M), Canada (\$225M), and Italy (\$185M).

What is Cuba's most valuable export?

Cuba's 5 most valuable exports are cigars and cigarettes, zinc ores and concentrates, nickel matte and oxide sinters, alcoholic beverages and wood charcoal. That leading quintet represents 47% of the total value for Cuban exports during 2024, a relatively strong concentration of products.

Does Cuba have a trade deficit?

Cuba has highly positive net exports in the international trade of tobacco and related products. In turn, these cashflows indicate Cuba's strong competitive advantages under the tobacco and manufactured substitutes product category. Overall, Cuba incurred an estimated -US\$2.96 billion trade deficit for 2024.
