

Distributed power generation for mobile base station equipment in Zimbabwe



Overview

What is the energy supply in Zimbabwe 2021?

In 2021, energy supply in Zimbabwe is a mix of hydropower (70%), coal (29%) and renewable energy sources, according to the Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority. Over the past five years, independent power producers (IPPs) have explored alternative energy sources such as solar, wind, geothermal, biofuels and biomass.

How much power does Zimbabwe import?

Currently power imports stand at around 400 MW. Industry and Commerce have struggled partly due to acute power shortages being experienced in the country. The Government of Zimbabwe has prioritised energy projects as one of the key enablers to economic growth and development.

How did ZPC finance Harare Power Station Repowering project?

Furthermore, the Bank also secured a mandate from ZPC to raise US\$11.2 million towards its 15% contribution of the EPC costs plus insurance cover for the Harare Power Station Repowering Project. The project is expected to be funded 85% with a concessional loan amounting to US\$70.2 million from India Exim Bank through the EPC contractor.
