Does the Dominican Republic have solar power plants



Overview

The installed renewable energy capacity in the Dominican Republic rose to 1,126.25 MW at the end of 2023 from 555.5 MW in 2020. There are currently over 1,300 MW of solar photovoltaic projects under construction in various parts of the country, according to the CNE. (USD 1.0 = EUR).
