What is Telecommunications in Guinea-Bissau?

Telecommunications in Guinea-Bissau include radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. Guinea-Bissau is one of the poorest countries in the world. This reality is reflected in the state of the country's telecommunications development.

What happened to Guinea-Bissau national radio after the coup?

Following the 12 April 2012 coup, the junta shut down all private radio stations and the national television station. They allowed only the national broadcaster, Guinea-Bissau National Radio, to broadcast intermittent military communiqués.

How will Guinea-Bissau support the development of a spectrum monitoring system?

Supporting development of the spectrum monitoring system, the objective is to install two more stations in Guinea-Bissau, completing the country's network of remote monitoring stations.

Does ANACOM have a remote station in Guinea-Bissau?

ANACOM is working with the Guinea-Bissau regulator, ARN-TIC - Autoridade Reguladora Nacional das Tecnologias de Informação e Comunicação da Guiné-Bissau (National Regulatory Authority of Information and Communication Technologies of Guinea-Bissau) to install a remote station in Guinea-Bissau, which uses software developed by ANACOM.

When will Guinea-Bissau's new spectrum monitoring station open?

With this station, opened on 22 November 2023, Guinea-Bissau's regulator will be able to conduct spectrum monitoring remotely, without having to move teams on the ground. This helps lower operating costs and increase efficiency

levels through greater capacity and speed of action.
