How much does sunroom insulation cost?

Sunroom insulation costs \$300 to \$1,500 or \$1 to \$4 per square foot. Other

insulation options are curtains, insulated panels, dual-pane windows, sub-deck protection, and sealing joints. A screen room or three-season sunroom doesn't require insulation. A sunroom roof costs \$500 to \$7,000, depending on the material.
