Panama has launched a 500MW tender auction for renewables and energy storage, the first in Central America to include storage. The bidding process - held by the national secretary of energy and state-owned electricity transmission company, Empresa de Transmisión Eléctrica SA (ETESA) - is seeking.

Harnessing abundant solar resources, an eco-resort located off the coast of Panama has chosen advanced lead batteries, paired with a battery management. The island microgrid is powered by a 355 kW photovoltaic (PV) array, which powers all appliances and systems on the island during the day.

But here's the kicker - their tropical location gives them world-class solar potential, yet daily cloud cover variations cause 25% energy production swings. Lithium battery storage isn't just an option anymore; it's becoming the linchpin of Panama's energy security. Last March, a 14-hour blackout.

The PEN (Plan Energético Nacional) 2015-2050 aims to drastically increase the use of renewable energy in Panama to 70% of the country's energy mix.
