# **Kyrgyzstan Communications Base Station Construction**



## Overview

---

In the early 2000s, use has expanded rapidly. Between 1999 and 2005, the number of Internet subscribers increased from 3,000 to 263,000. In 2004 some 12,300 were in operation. The top level domain is .kg. Variable upload/download speeds through xDSL are available through state t.

How many HVAC transmission lines are in Tajikistan & Kyrgyzstan?

A total of 598 km of HVAC transmission lines running across Tajikistan (142 km) to connect to the CASA-1000 HVAC transmission lines in Kyrgyzstan (456 km) at the Tajik – Kyrgyz border. In total, 4,264 transmission towers will be constructed, of which 2,247 were complete at October 10, 2022.

What telecommunications are available in Kyrgyzstan?

Telecommunications in Kyrgyzstan include fixed and mobile telephones and the Internet.

Will the Trans-Asia-Europe fiber optic line affect broadband prices in Kyrgyzstan?

There is a major telecommunications project under construction - The Trans-Asia-Europe Fiber Optic Line, connecting Shanghai, China and Frankfurt, Germany, with the capacity of 622 Mbit/s, where Kyrgyzstan has completed its part. Completion of this project might affect broadband internet prices in Kyrgyzstan.

How long will the power lines run through Kyrgyzstan?

The total length of the power lines running through Kyrgyzstan starting at the 500 kV bay at “Datka” Substation will be 456 kilometers.

Which ISPs are in Kyrgyzstan?

ISPs in Kyrgyzstan include Kyrgyz Telecom, Elcat, Asiainfo, Transfer Ltd, Totel, Megaline, Aknet, Intranet, Saima Telecom, My4G, Rikonet, AlaTV, ExNET, and IPSWICH. Since the early 2020s, Kyrgyzstan has seen rapid development in the internet sector, accompanied by the expansion of communication

channels and modernization of infrastructure.

Does Kyrgyzstan have a mobile network?

Mobile network operators have actively expanded coverage, including in remote and hard-to-reach areas, despite the country's mountainous terrain. As of the mid-2020s, mobile networks cover more than 99% of the populated territory of Kyrgyzstan. In the early 2000s, Internet use has expanded rapidly.
