Why is China building a 100 MW solar power plant in Kyrgyzstan?

Kemin, Kyrgyzstan — In a significant step toward enhancing Kyrgyzstan's energy infrastructure, China has begun construction of a 100 MW solar power plant in the city of Kemin, located in the Chuy Region. The project underscores Kyrgyzstan's commitment to sustainable energy development and environmental preservation.

What is Kyrgyzstan's solar project?

The project underscores Kyrgyzstan's commitment to sustainable energy development and environmental preservation. The solar plant, once operational, is expected to generate 155 million kWh of electricity annually, contributing to the country's energy needs while reducing reliance on fossil fuels.

What will IFC do for Kyrgyz energy?

IFC will advise the Kyrgyz Ministry of Energy and the Ministry of Economy and Commerce on structuring a public-private partnership (PPP) to mobilize private sector experience and capital to construct and operate a pilot solar plant.

Which countries have commissioned solar plants in 2021?

Uzbekistan, Senegal, and Zambia have already successfully commissioned plants under Scaling Solar, and more projects are at different stage of development in a number of countries, including Côte d'Ivoire, Niger, and Togo. Globally, in 2021, IFC delivered 32 percent in own-account climate finance and mobilized \$3.6 billion for climate.

Why is Kyrgyz Republic a good place to live?

The Kyrgyz Republic is endowed with abundant and largely untapped renewable resources, providing a viable and competitive solution to meet its growing demand while expanding its power mix.
