What is a small body in the Solar System?

Any natural solar system object other than the Sun, a planet, a dwarf planet, or a moon is called a small body; these include asteroids, meteoroids, and comets. Most of the more than one million asteroids, or minor planets, orbit between Mars and Jupiter in a nearly flat ring called the asteroid belt.

How many planets are in the Solar System?

The solar system has one star, eight planets, five dwarf planets, at least 290 moons, more than 1.3 million asteroids, and about 3,900 comets.

How many Earths are inside the Sun?

Solar flare from the sun. The Sun is the heart of our solar system, and its sheer size is mind-boggling. It accounts for 99.86% of the total mass of the solar system, with the remaining 0.14% shared among planets, moons, asteroids, and comets. To put this into perspective, you could fit about 1.3 million Earths inside the Sun.

How fast does our Solar System orbit?

Our solar system orbits the center of the galaxy at about 515,000 mph (828,000 kph). It takes about 230 million years to complete one orbit around the galactic center. An artist's concept of our solar system. Learn about the inner planets, the outer planets, and the dwarf planets.

How many moons are there in the Solar System?

Our solar system has hundreds of moons, and they come in a variety of shapes and sizes. Many moons orbit planets, and even some asteroids have moons. Hyperion is the largest of Saturn's irregularly shaped moons.

How many dwarf planets are in the Solar System?

Jupiter and Saturn possess nearly 90% of the non-stellar mass of the Solar System. There are a vast number of less massive objects. There is a strong consensus among astronomers that the Solar System has at least nine dwarf planets: Ceres, Orcus, Pluto, Haumea, Quaoar, Makemake, Gonggong, Eris, and Sedna.
