Overview

Sept 24 (Interfax) - Russia's Energy Ministry is considering the possibility of building a pumped storage power plant (PSPP) in the Nadezhdinsky District and a new thermal power plant (TPP) based at the Novoshakhtinskoye coal deposit with capacity of 400 MW in the Primorsk Territory, the ministry's press service said following a working meeting between Energy Minister Sergei Tsivilev and Primorye Governor Oleg Kozhemyako.
