Overview

Norway-based independent power producer (IPP) Scatec has started operations on three solar-plus-storage projects in South Africa, totalling 1,140MWh of BESS capacity. Who is supplying battery energy storage systems in South Africa?

Source: Eskom. A Chinese green technology company has been contracted to supply battery energy storage systems (BESS) for the Oasis 1 cluster of projects in South Africa. Envision Energy announced the contract with the EDF Group, to supply three battery energy storage systems (BESS) amounting to 257MW of capacity and 1,028MWh of storage.

How much energy storage capacity does South Africa have?

South Africa had 1,604.6kW of capacity in 2022 and this is expected to rise to 3,519.9kW by 2030. Listed below are the five largest energy storage projects by capacity in South Africa, according to GlobalData's power database. GlobalData uses proprietary data and analytics to provide a complete picture of the global energy storage segment.

Is Scatec launching a battery energy storage project in South Africa?

In October 2024, Scatec reached financial close for a battery energy storage project totalling 103 MW/ 412 MWh by the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy in South Africa under the Battery Energy Storage Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (BESIPPPP). The power will be dispatched under a 15-year PPA.

Is Envision Energy the largest energy storage system supplier in South Africa?

Envision Energy announced the contract with the EDF Group, to supply three battery energy storage systems (BESS) amounting to 257MW of capacity and 1,028MWh of storage. The company claims this marks the largest BESS order in South Africa and positions it as the first energy storage system supplier in the region to secure a GWh-scale order.
