In March 2015, members of the Parliament of South Ossetia put forward a proposal to dissolve South Ossetia's military and fold it into the Russian Armed Forces, but the proposal was ultimately rejected by South Ossetian President Leonid Tibilov and Defense Minister Ibrahim Gassayev.

Where is South Ossetia located?

They had accounted for about a third of the population prior to the collapse of the Soviet Union. South Ossetia is separated from Russia's North Ossetia region by a border running high in the Caucasus mountains. President: Alan Gagloev.

How many people live in South Ossetia?

Most of the remaining inhabitants of South Ossetia are Georgians. Its capital is Tskhinvali. Pop. (2014) 53,532; (2016 est.) 53,000. South Ossetia is deeply intersected by rivers, which are harnessed for hydroelectric power.
