# **The largest sodium-ion energy storage project**



## Overview

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Sineng Electric's 50 MW/100 MWh sodium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS) project in China's Hubei province is the first phase of a larger plan that will eventually reach 100 MW/200 MWh. The initial capacity has already been connected to the grid and can power around 12,000 households for an.

The first phase of the world's largest sodium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS), in China, has come online. The first 50MW/100MWh portion of the project in Qianjiang, Hubei province has been completed and put into operation, state-owned media outlet Yicai Global and technology provider HiNa.

The world's largest Sodium-ion Battery energy storage system has gone into operation in Qianjiang, Hubei Province, China. This significant achievement involved the first phase of Datang Group's 100 MW/200 MWh sodium-ion energy storage project, which was successfully connected to the grid on June.
