Türkiye's 35 GWh storage capacity accounts for grid-scale projects alone. Global energy storage investments have surpassed 150 GWh. Türkiye has already begun installations in Hungary, Bulgaria, and Spain, leveraging its geographic advantage close to Europe.

Is Polat Energy Turkey's largest battery energy storage system?

Once commissioned, the facility will be Turkey's largest battery energy storage system. Polat Energy is an established renewables developer in Turkey, owning approximately 6% of the country's installed wind energy capacity with a cumulative power output of around 660 MW.
