The president of Guatemala is the commander-in-chief of the military, and formulates policy, training, and budget through the Minister of Defence.

When did Guantanamo Bay become a Naval Air Station?

Naval Air Station Guantanamo Bay was officially established 1 February 1941. Aircraft routinely operating out of McCalla included JRF-5, N3N, J2F, C-1 Trader, and dirigibles. The airfield was deactivated in the 1970s and was used to house Cuban and Haitian refugees beginning in the 1990s.
