

Yaoundé Energy's 9 billion energy storage project



Overview

Yaoundé is implementing an integrated distributed power generation, storage and management system in order to ensure a secure energy supply for its street lighting assets, a project with multiple implications for the 2.7 million residents and businesses of the African city. Is China entering a new era of energy storage demand?

Mainland China accounts for most of the global energy storage demand, driven in the near term by regional requirements for new utility-scale wind and solar projects to include energy storage capacity. However, the Chinese market is entering an era of change.

What drives energy storage project development?

Globally, energy storage project development is increasingly driven by the utility-scale segment, with mandates and targeted auctions driving gigawatt-hour projects in markets like China, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Australia and Chile.

Where are gigawatt-hour projects being built?

Since 2024, gigawatt-hour projects have been commissioned or started construction in not only the US and China, but also Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Australia, Netherlands, Chile, Canada and the UK.

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
